Real Desire, one of the greatest racehorses of modern times and the richest living pacing stallion in the world, is heading down under for the 2007 breeding season.

His new Southern Hemisphere base will be the prestigious Alabar New Zealand property on the outskirts of Auckland.

Not only is Real Desire a racing megastar he is also one of the leading sires in North America today. Amazingly, with his first crop of three year olds, Real Desire has the richest three year old in North America (Tell All) and also the fastest three year old in North America (Running Book).

Two weeks ago Tell All blitzed the best three year olds in North America in the world's richest pacing race, the \$1.5 million North America Cup.

Another first crop son of Real Desire in Running Book last week scorched to victory in his elimination of the \$1 million Meadowlands Pace in 1:48.4 – harness racing's first sub 1:49 three year old of 2007 and the fastest ever Meadowlands Pace Elimination winner.

In Saturday night's final of the Meadowlands Pace, Tell All placed second in what was an enormous mile. He was parked outside the leader and hit the front at the top of the straight holding off all challengers only to be cut down late by the flying rails finish of Southwind Lynx.

Tell All's seasonal earnings now stand at \$1,065,005 making him harness racing's richest performer in 2007.

Real Desire will shuttle between Auckland and Harrisburg, Pennsylvania.

Up until this season he has stood at Brittany Farm in Kentucky but he has now moved to Pennsylvania to take advantage of their slots-enriched sires stakes programme.

To get to second on the North American three year old sires list without the backing of a rich sires stakes programme is phenomenal.

Lizzie Maguire On Song For Dixon's Attempt At Trifecta

Harness Jewels pacing princess Lizzie Maguire (Christian Cullen x Unrehearsed) is looking good to represent New Zealand in the 2yo fillies section of the rich Breeders Crown at Ballarat (Victoria) in August.

The winner of the \$200,000 2YO Diamond for the fillies at Ashburton on June 2 has enjoyed a 10-day let-up since her emphatic southern victory, and trainer Gareth Dixon is a happy man leading into her qualifying heat at Alexandra Park on Friday night, July 20.

"I haven't done a whole lot with her but her work has been really good," said Dixon late last week.

"She will go straight into the heat without a trial.

"We're not counting our chickens - but she should be too good for them (only two unraced fillies will take her on Alexandra Park this Friday night).

"I ran her up a wee bit last Saturday (July 7) in work and she worked really nice. But I haven't wanted to tighten the screws just yet," he added.

If Lizzie Maguire is successful in the Breeders Crown Final on August 19 at Ballarat, it would secure an incredible trifecta for Dixon who has from two previous attempts taken Breeders Crown Finals with former star young trotter Super Command in 2004 and 2005.

"I may trial her before we go (to Australia)," he said.

"The semi's are on the 14th of August, and the final on the 19th - I won't start her before that."

Dixon has prepared a plan to win the Crown and will stick by it, his confidence in the filly high, and he rates her chances of taking the Jewels-Breeders Crown double.

"She had about 10 days off after the Jewels but hasn't lost a of fitness - I think she's in the top two or three fillies in New Zealand.

"And while I don't know a lot about the Aussie fillies, I think she's a big hope."

Bred by Jubilee Park's Ray and Diana Kennedy, and owned by Helen Hoggard, Lizzie Maguire will have a good spell following her Australian campaign, Dixon keen to concentrate on the wealth of money at the back-end of the new season.

"She may not be about until after the Christmas racing," said the leading trainer.

"There is enough later on - she will be back for the Jewels and Breeders Crown again, the Nevele R Fillies Series, and the Oaks races.

"If you don't wait and give them a break now then you only end up giving them a week or 10 days out and that is not ideal so we'll wait until after Christmas."

Dixon has turned out the highly-promising Ebony Gem (Island Fantasy x Payson's Gem), a three-year-old who looked the equal of the top colts and geldings earlier in the term before a mid-season slump.

He goes to the paddock as a C1 horse, though the winner of six races.

"He should could back as a nice C1, shouldn't he?" mused Dixon.

"Both myself and his owners Steve and Anne Phillips have been a bit disappointed in him at times. But I know in himself he has turned the corner and is back to his best.

"I've always had a good opinion of him and he should make his way through the grades next season.

"He will have two months out and I'll get him ready for Christmas racing - he won't be going to the Cup meeting (Addington)."

The Flyin Doctor In 1:50.0 In Meadowlands Debut

Former top Canterbury pacer The Flyin Doctor (6g Sands A Flyin x Alice In Wonderland) won his Meadowlands debut on Sunday (NZT) in 1:50 for the mile.

The Flyin Doctor settled third on markers, then moved off to trail on the outer through the opening half in 53.2s.

After being left in the open approaching the 3/4, The Flyin Doctor was full of steam, powering to a clear lead turning for home.

He won easing down by over four lengths for driver George Brennan in the \$US23,500 pace.

The former Tim Butt/Phil Anderson-trained pacer had won two of three lead-up American starts.

The Flyin Doctor ran 1:54.2 (half-mile track) when winning first-up at Freehold, New Jersey, for trainer Richard Norman in late May.

He won again, going a faster 1:52.8 on the 1000m track at Pocono Downs, Pennsylvania, late last month.

Sunday's win came in the final race on the same programme as the \$US1 million Meadowlands Pace, won by Southwind Lynx with a late inside run in 1:49.1 (5th).

Southwind Lynx is a colt by Real Artist from a Jate Lobell mare in Luxury Class, trained by George Teague jun, and driven by Tim Tetrick.

Ex-Kiwis, Allstar Blue Jean and Extender, picked up good second place cheques in earlier races on the Meadowlands programme.

* Pacific Blue Jean (7g Falcon Seelster x Seafeld Faye), who still holds the NZ 3YO 2400m stand record at 2:59.8, notched his 7th American win for the year at Pocono Downs today.

Formerly with Ashburton trainer John Hay, Pacific Blue Jean was sold to America as a stallion, but gelded later in life than usual.

Pacific Blue Jean led again, this time from the five gate, and held in 1:53.6 to take his yearly earnings close to \$US70,000.

* Former Canterbury filly Express Ball (4m Presidential Ball x My Barbie Doll) is one of the best winning mares (numerically) in America this year.

Express Ball, formerly co-owned by Malcolm Shinn and Lew Driver, racked up her 11th win of the year when coming from last of the six to win a \$US15,000 fillies and mares open pace at Saratoga, New York, last Friday.

She has won over \$US86,000 in her debut year in the States.

* Jayden's Lady (4m Live Or Die x Lady Geovin) continued her good form, winning a \$C14,000 mares pace at Mohawk, Canada, on Saturday (NZ time) in 1:53.8 (10ths).

The former Jimmy Curtin-trained mare started favourite for trainer Virgil Morgan, and driver Luc Ouellette.

Ex-Southland mares to shine were Laura Lane (6m Holmes Hanover x Vera Lillian) and Golden Falcon (7m Falcon Seelster x Kanegold).

Laura Lane won a \$US15,000 pace on the half-mile at Yonkers, New York, leading up to win by five lengths in 1:55.2.

This was the 6th win of the year for the former Earl Swain-trained mare, for earnings of \$US60,000. She has a 1:52.8 mile mark on a mile track.

Golden Falcon kept her top form going with a \$US15,000 win at Tioga Downs, New York, in 1:53.4 (1000m track).

Miss Livia (5m Beach Towel x Lady Melody) was a front-running winner of a \$US7000 pace at Tioga, going 1:55.2.

* Former northern trotter No More Gold (8g Evanders Gold x Repent In Eden) won a \$US10,000 trot at Buffalo Raceway on Saturday (NZ time) in 1:57.

Zaire (10g Gee Whiz x Perdita), featured in these columns last week, won his 10th from 15 starts for the year at Yonkers Raceway last Thursday, going 1:59.6.

No Shortcutz (6g Live Or Die x Take The Cake) was a runaway winner on the same day at Yonkers, winning a \$US5000 pace in 1:56.8.

Anvil Raider (7g In The Pocket x Motu Sweet Lady) led and won a \$US6500 pace in 1:56.2 at Hazel Park Raceway on Friday.

Friday NZ-bred winners on the mile track at Cal Expo, California, were: N Wong (8g OK Bye x Girl's Best Friend) in 1:58.6 and Indigo Franco (7m Holmes Hanover x Imperial Franco) in 1:59.

Tumble (6g In The Pocket x Vault) ended a run of minor placings when winning his first for the year at Yonkers Raceway on Friday, leading up in a \$US7000 pace to win in 1:56.4.

Flashing Red Brave With Super Second In Comeback Race

Warhorse Flashing Red (Echelon X Courvy Kazi) finished a stunning second behind Australasia's best Grand Circuit pacer Blacks A Fake in last Saturday night's \$A11,000 Campbell Gladstones Pace (2138m) at Albion Park, Brisbane.

The New Zealand Cup-Auckland Cup winning stallion arrived three-wide at the bell and was posted there for the remainder of the race outside of Blacks A Fake, who led at the 1400m, and Cobbitty Classic, parked at the bell.

Flashing Red never yielded in the straight, even taking ground off Blacks A Fake over the final stages, a super comeback for the rising 10-year-old.

He is expected to stay on in Australia until late October before rejoining the Tim Butt-Phil Anderson stable in Christchurch.

Star Australian filly Miss Hazel (Presidential Ball x My Ami Lee) bounced back to winning form at Ballarat, Victoria, on Saturday, easily disposing of five others in a 3YO fillies pace over 2200 metres.

Driver Gavin Lang urged the winner of now 10 from 14 starts to the lead from gate six, never looking under threat to win easily.

Miss Hazel was beaten into second behind Dance Of Life (Live Or Die x The Magic Dancer) at her last start in the Victorian Oaks on March 24, but appears to have thrived on a break.

She has now set up a much-awaited clash with top New Zealand filly One Dream and last week's Queensland Oaks winner Dance Of Life in this Saturday's Group 1 \$A75,000 Nevele R Stud Australian Oaks at Moonee Valley.

Former Kiwi filly Quick Flow (Washington V C x Quick As A Franco) challenged at the 400m but couldn't finish it off, running fourth.

She has failed to win in five Australian starts after looking smart for former Canterbury trainer Andrew McPherson.

A recent Auckland visitor in All Promises (4m Albert Albert x As Promised) bounced back to her best form in winning the \$A30,000 Campbell's Wholesale 4 & 5YO Championship at Albion Park.

All Promises travelled across to tackle the four-year-olds in the Taylor Mile and NZ Messenger at Alexandra Park, but failed to gain enough money to secure a Harness Jewels spot at Ashburton.

Since returning to Australia she has had a fourth in the \$100,000 Queen Of The Pacific at Moonee Valley, and latterly three wins at Albion Park for trainer Shannon Price.

Lola Weidemann did the driving tonight. All Promises sat three-wide on the pace for the final 800m, overpowering warm favourite and leader Jogonalong Joel (Our Sir Vancelot x Miss Jogonalong) in the run home.

Lombo Pocket Watch (Jet Laag x Misty Maiden) was surprisingly beaten but far from disgraced in the \$75,000 Campbell's Wholesale Queensland Derby (2680m).

Driver Gavin Fitzpatrick had to ease the champion colt back to last from a wide draw and was left to make his own way into the race over the final lap, three-wide without cover.

He never stopped trying, but could not withstand the finishing burst of local hero Arkamigo (Armbro Operative x Ark Maree) who followed Lombo Pocket Watch forward from the 600m.

Arkamigo has now won nine of 25 starts. He was driven by top Queensland driver Grant Dixon.

Be Diligent (D M Dillinger x Glammatot), previously the winner of 11 from 14 starts, was huge in third after working up wide to sit parked, never shirking the task.
