Race One Beaudiene Bad Babe Crystal Star Amboseli Telemecanique

Beaudiene Bad Babe (11) deserves her favourites tag, the barrier draw probably the only thing standing in her way. Outstanding form leading into this, and she looks the one for punters to get away on the right foot. Crystal Star (9) will need Amboseli (1) to hold the lead if she is to win. That scenario is rather possible given the latter's gatespeed and ability to lead. Crystal Star is the toughest in the race and she would cap a great season with a win. Her stablemate Telemecanique (8) was only just beaten last week and looks in the right form to threaten despite the terrible draw. Indrah (3) and Imagine Me (13) seem the likely threats to that top four.

Race Two Paramount Geegee Kylie Ree Springbank Sam Madisonz Luck

Local hope Paramount Geegee (11) was beaten for the first time when he last raced, and that was by Kylie Ree (3) who seems the logical threat in the same form. They both went very well at last Saturday's workouts on this track and seem to have arrived at the big day in good shape. We'll tip Paramount Geegee to win, and it'd be a popular victory for trainer, John Dickie, who also has a big day ahead of him in his Clubhouse Sports Bar on-course at Cambridge. Springbank Sam (9) is unquestionably very talented and capable of winning, while there has been a big push for another local, Madisonz Luck (7) in recent weeks, though that talk has dulled somewhat in the past few days.

Race Three Bettor Cover Lover Miss Elsie Collectable Bettor Move It

Bettor Cover Lover (13) has swept almost all before her this season, winning the ones that mattered, beaten only a half-neck in the Cauduceus Classic by Paradise City before big wins in the Sales Series and Sires Stakes Finals. She trialed enormous here last Saturday and is clearly the one to beat. She can overcome unlucky number 13. Miss Elsie (8) is the big threat. She gets a terrible draw and that's a shame. But she is capable of coming from off the speed here, and may be helped by Bettor Cover Lover being back there early, too. They look a strong pair. Collectable (1) has gone off the boil, and that can be traced back to chasing the field three starts ago after galloping, a massive but very taxing run to finish fourth. She is good enough but maybe 20 percent her best. Highview Ebony (9) is a genuine filly with some chance, as are Anvils Delight (2), Paradise City (6), and Bettor Move It (11).

Race Four Miami H Kahdon Chocolate Brownie Vulcan

Miami H (3) looked in a little trouble at a certain stage of the lucrative summer and autumn season, but he's bounced back to his very best and looks now the clear horse to beat over a suitable distance off a perfect draw. Hard to see him not leading, and he does look the one most will anchor. Kahdon (12) has been flying and she is undoubtedly the danger. A brilliant 2:43.8 (2200m) win at Alex Park on Saturday to prepare her for this. Has changed ownership, and driver this week. She will join the Mark Jones stable immediately after the race. Chocolate Brownie (5) has a card to play. He is the fastest over a 200m sprint and if able to unleash that off a nice run he may cause some trouble. That's his best chance. Emma Hamilton (1) should trail and get the run, a trifecta must. Vulcan (6) regained winning form last time and should also figure in the placings.

Race Five De Lovely Lancome Meredith Maguire Secret Potion

NZ Oaks winner De Lovely showed her amazing class when just demoralising them at Addington. Her high speed was matched by a quality staying performance that night. Drawn to dominate, though gate one may not be as ideal as it seems. The clear top pick, but not a moral to win. The Purdon-Payne stablemates, Lancome (2), Secret Potion (4), and Meredith Maguire (11) are all top quality and will cash in on any chinks in the De Lovely armour. Lancome's draw possibly gives her an edge over the other two and her sprint distance record is very good. Consider Royal Cee Cee (3) and Indulge (9) in multiple bets.

Race Six I Can Doosit Ima Gold Digger Dr Hook Great Getaway

On his form throughout the season this should fall to I Can Doosit (10), a quality young trotter who was far from disgraced when fifth to champion squaregaiter Sundon's Gift in the Rowe Cup when last produced. His draw is actually quite good, and there shouldn't be too many obstacles in his way once they settle. Ima Gold Digger (8) has recaptured his brilliant juvenile form and what a time to do it. Another very slick run when he won at the workouts here on Saturday. Should jump the gate and go forward, he looks the leader at some stage. Dr Hook (12) has grown a leg in the past six weeks and has become a real threat. His draw isn't great, but he will stay better than most and can therefore work during the middle-stages and still fight on. A clear top three with Great Getaway (5) and Jumanji Franco (9) next-best.

Race Seven Major Mark The Muskeg Express Le Sol Thumpem

A great battle to erupt here with two very smart youngsters drawn to go to war. Major Mark (1) was fair by his standards in the Sales Final when fourth, though back to his best when a slick Sires Stakes winner last time out. Gate one may not be the best draw for him, but undeniably the one they all have to beat. The Muskeg Express (3) is confidently expected to win if he can keep his gait. Would have won the Sales Final but galloped late, the broke early and flew home in Sires. A horse going right to the top. Le Sol (13) is going great and a must in all bets, while Zenola Seelster (2), God Send (5), and Thumpem (9) have some claims.

Race Eight Sleepy Tripp Tintin In America Still Coughin Second Wind

A really interesting race, the race we've all looked at 100 times over and wondered – just what will happen here?! Tintin In America (9) deserves to be favourite, he's going terrific. But, the big but. His draw isn't good, or at least it could very well be rather tricky for him. Lots of speed off the front line may see Highview Tommy (1) crossed. Though with early speed that plays into Tintin's hands if he can get off the markers and a crack at them. Sleepy Tripp (12) looks the swooper. He is top class, the Easter Cup winner this season and luckless in the 4yo classics. Stick with him. Early speed from smart pacers Romulus (3), Still Coughin (5), and Second Wind (6). They are capable of fast miles and a cheap quarter could get any of that trio home. Harley Earl (8) has some chance though the draw is no good for him.

Race Nine Russley Rascal Hip Hop Anvil Gomeo Romeo Captain Peacock

The best for last? Possibly, though I believe the previous race is the most enthralling because of the lack of a clear pattern. The pattern may be a little easier to predict here. Russley Rascal (1) has been the best-backed of all runners on the day since the markets opened on Sunday. He's red-hot in demand in multi bets, though the big-hitters have liked the \$1.80, into \$1.50 in single betting, too. He's just top class this horse and it would be a surprise if he was to be crossed out of the gate. Hip Hop Anvil (9) is the likely trailer and a huge chance with the last shot up the passing lane. This is a very good horse and Russley Rascal's driver Blair Orange will have genuine concerns if he knows Hip Hop Anvil in on his back coming to the turn. Some top horses have drawn worse and have a big day's work ahead of them if they are to win. NZ Derby winner Captain Peacock (12), Sir Lincoln (11), Kotare Mach (8), and Gomeo Romeo (2) are that selective bunch. Picking this to be the fastest race on the day as Russley Rascal may have to scoot early to hold up, then fend off some action mid-race.
